The investment has proven to raise student self esteem, increase student kindness, reduce bullying, improve school climate, and inspire community service.

The most life-changing part of the Project is participation in a Challenge Day. Challenge Days are powerful, high energy programs in which youth and adult participants are guided through a series of experiential learning processes.

The overall goals of the program are to:

- increase personal power and self-esteem
- shift dangerous peer pressure to positive peer support
- eliminate the acceptability of teasing, violence and all forms of oppression
- unite and to carry the themes of the program back to the greater school population
